



DOCARE Earnest A. Allaby Award Guidelines and Prerequisites

This award is given in recognition of outstanding service to DOCARE through the promotion of DOCARE'S values, goals and service. The nominee may be a physician or non-physician, but must have excelled in service to DOCARE and shown a desire to further DOCARE's cause.

The DOCARE award selection committee will consider all applicants for this award. All active DOCARE members, as well as full DOCARE chapters, may submit a nomination for consideration.

Nominees for this award are not required to be an active member. Past members, non-members and organizations will also be considered.

The DOCARE award selection committee will consider numerous criteria for this award including, but not limited to, the following service to the DOCARE organization:

- Promotion at the local, state, national or international level in furthering the values, goals, and ideals for which DOCARE stands for.
- Philanthropic support of the DOCARE organization, in the form of monetary support or supplies to DOCARE missions.

- Date of Application
- Name of Nominator
- Name of Nominee
- Number of years associated with DOCARE
- Nominees' contribution for DOCARE (up to 100 words)

In addition to basic information, a single letter of endorsement from the person or organization making the nomination should be submitted. Please limit the letter to one page in length.

Submissions will be accepted up to August 1, 2019, for consideration at the meeting of the awards committee and for presentation at the DOCARE general meeting at the OMED conference in October 2019.
